Survival Signs Software, the interactive version of the popular *Survival Signs Curriculum*, teaches students to identify important signs found at school and in the community. The easy-to-use software, developed by PCI's Janie Haugen, is ideal for practice and review either alone or in conjunction with any of the *Survival Signs* programs.

The software features 40 indoor and 40 outdoor survival signs presented using international symbols and illustrations. Narration and voice prompts guide students, making the program effective for visual learners and those with limited or no reading skills.

Survival Signs Software teaches the signs with the following activities:

- Learn the Signs.** Players view each of the signs and listen to extended explanations
- Choose the Sign 1.** Two signs are displayed, the words on one of the signs are read aloud by the narrator, and players decide which of the two signs is the correct match. This activity has two levels. Level 1: picture symbols and words are shown on the signs. Level 2: words have been removed and only the picture symbols are shown
- Choose the Sign 2.** Same as Sign 1, except three signs are displayed
- Match the Sign.** One sign without words is displayed; students match the correct meaning to the sign

Indoor Survival Signs. This set assists individuals in recognizing survival signs they need to know when inside a facility: Accessible; Ask for Restroom Key; Automatic Door; Caution; Closed (Sorry, we are...), Do Not Touch; Elevator; Escalator; Exit; Fire Extinguisher; First Aid; Flammable; Food; Guide Dogs Allowed; Hard Hat Area; In and

Out; In Case of Fire, Use Stairs; Keep Out; Men's Restroom; No Alcohol or Drugs; No Food or Drinks; No Pets; No Smoking; No Weapons; Not an Exit; Open (Yes, we are...); Out of Order; Poison; Recycle; Restroom; Shoplifters Will Be Prosecuted; Slippery When Wet; Smoking Area; Stairs; Waiting Area; Wash Hands Before Returning to Work; Watch Your Step; Water Fountain; Wet Floor; Wet Paint; Women's Restroom.

Outdoor Survival Signs. This set assists individuals in recognizing survival signs they need to know when walking in their neighborhood or community: Airport; Beware of Dog; Bike Route; Buckle Up for Safety; Bus Stop; Call 911 Emergency; Do Not Enter; Don't Walk; Fire Station; Flood Gauge; High Voltage/Danger; Hospital; Keep Off the Grass; Neighborhood Crime Watch; No Bicycles; No Diving; No Parking; No Swimming; No Trespassing; No Walking; One Way; Pedestrian Crossing; Phone; Picnic Area; Pitch In!; Railroad Crossing; Reserved Parking—for Persons with Physical Disabilities; School Xing; School Xing/Hearing Impairments; School Zone/Speed Limit 20; Signal Ahead; Slow/Children at Play; Speed Limit 30; Stop; Stop Ahead; Street Crossing; Walk; Wrong Way; Yield; Yield Ahead.

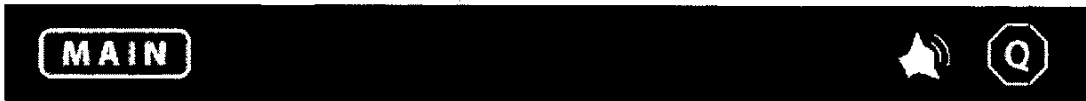


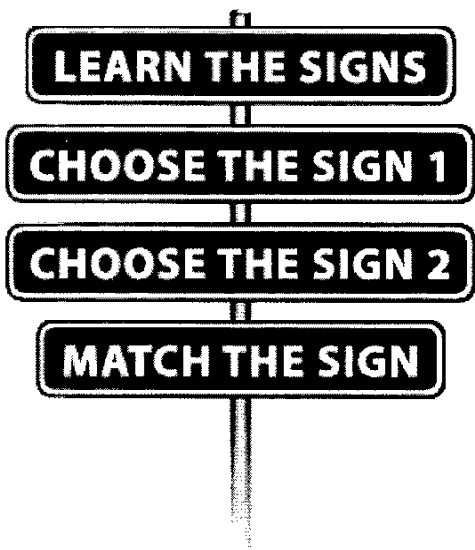

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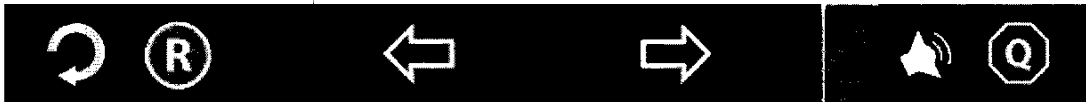
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 **OUTDOOR** Survival Signs  



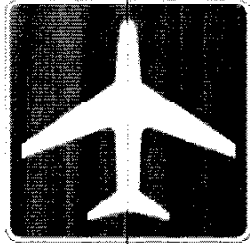

Activity Scores: If the user chooses the correct answer first, their score for this sign is 5 points. For each wrong choice on that sign, the score goes down by 1. For example if it takes a user 2 wrong choices before choosing the correct sign, the score for that sign is 3.

Sign Difficulties: Each time user choose an incorrect sign, the Sign Difficulty score is increased by 1, indicating possible problem areas.

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
